Primary Project

We are thrilled to introduce Primary Project at GCCS! This evidence-based program from the Children's Institute supports primary grade children in maximizing their school experience. Trained associates will work one-on-one with students to enhance social skills, build confidence, and ease school transitions.

HOW IT WORKS:

Students are identified through classroom observations and teacher recommendations. After discussing the program's benefits with parents, selected students will engage in weekly 30-minute sessions for 12-15 weeks in a playroom setting. Through play, they will develop decision-making, creative problem-solving, and risk-taking skills. The Primary Project team will keep teachers, parents, and administrators informed with program data.
